

## **Professor Paweł Strumiłło**



The current director of the Institute of Electronics.

He was born in 1959 in Lodz. He received the MSc degree in electronics and in 1983 was employed at the Institute of Electronics as an assistant. His scientific specialty is medical electronics. To this field of study he devoted the doctoral dissertation defended in 1993 at the University of Strathclyde in Scotland and the habilitation thesis, which he defended at the Lodz University of Technology in 2002. In 2013, he received the title of full professor in technical sciences. In years 1998-2005 he served as a deputy director of the Institute and in years 2005-2015 was the head of the Medical Electronics Division. He has published more than 200 scientific papers covering topics in biomedical signal processing, image analysis, computational intelligence and human-computer interaction systems. The last few years of his research he has focused on running projects on electronic aids for the blind (the recent project is the Horizon 2020 grant). He is the author and co-author of three books, he promoted 7 doctors of sciences. He is a Senior Member of the Institute of Electrical and Electronics Engineers (IEEE).
