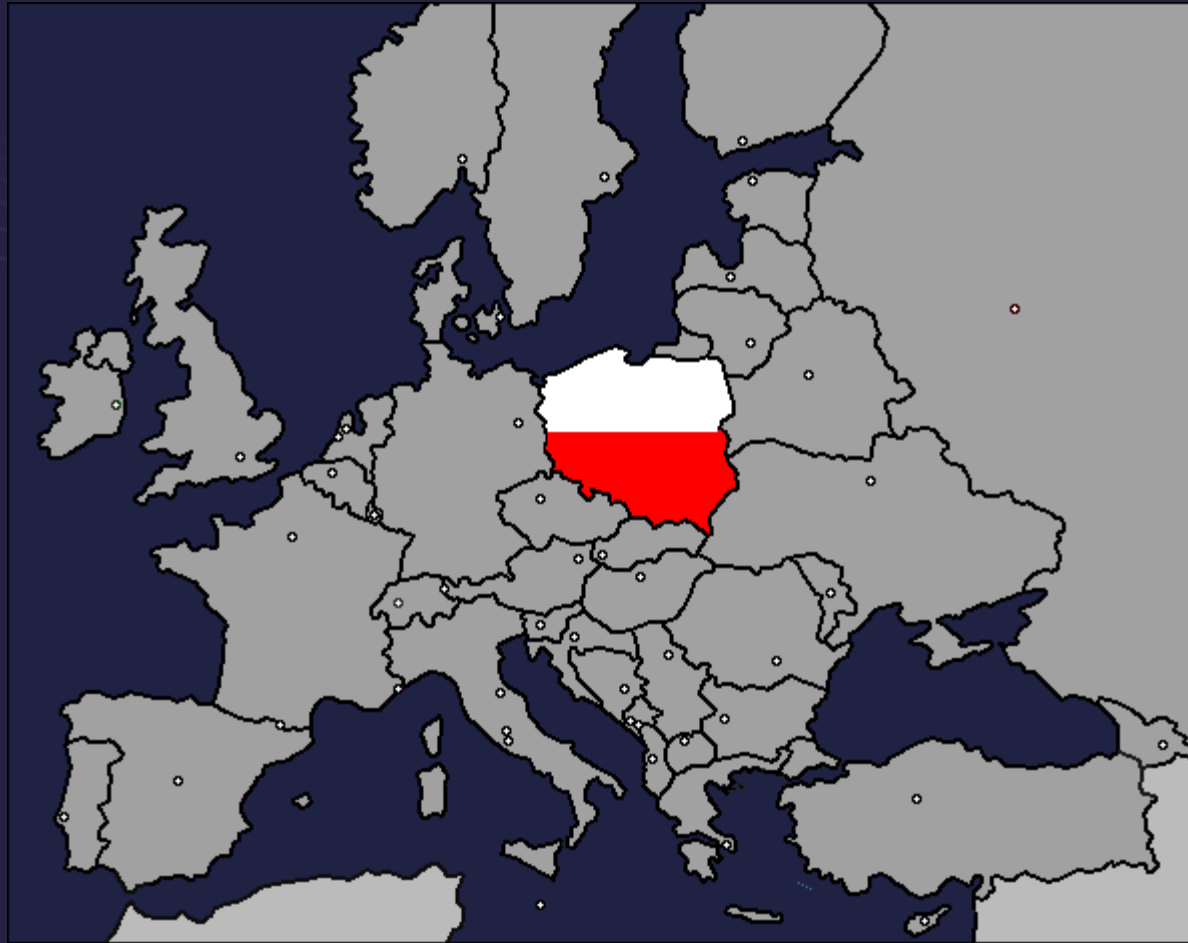

- Train/bus/car from central/eastern Europe

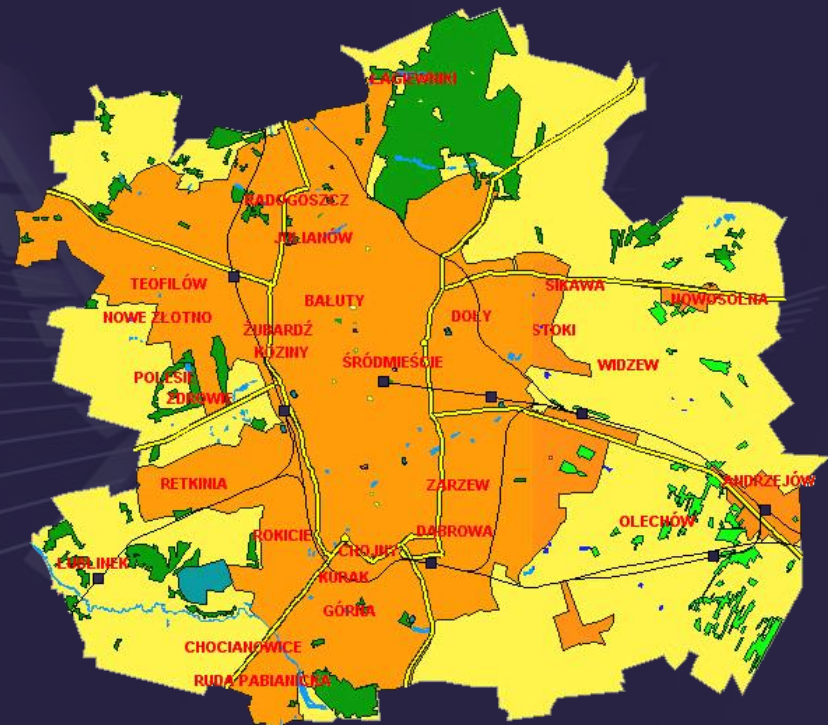




The city of Łódź:

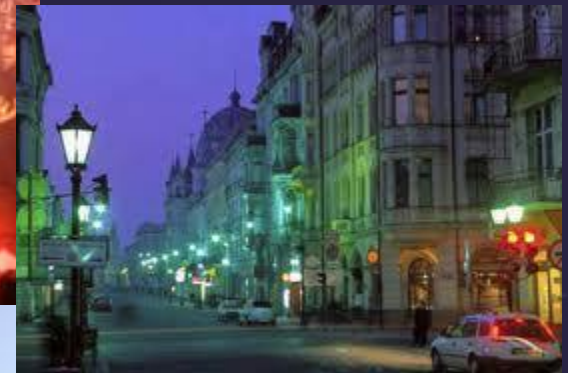

 - Science and Technology

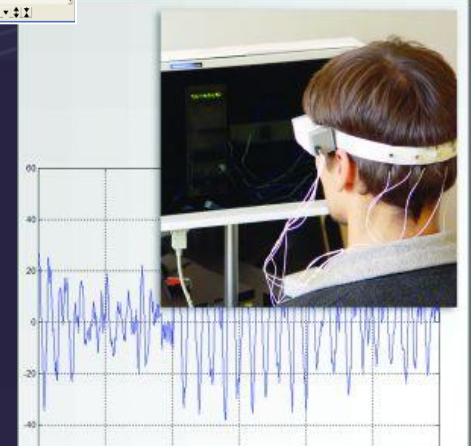
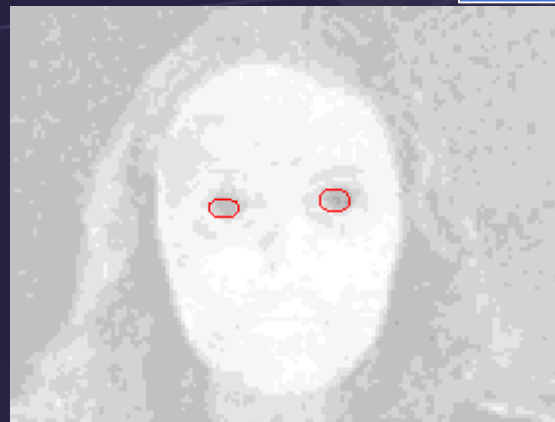
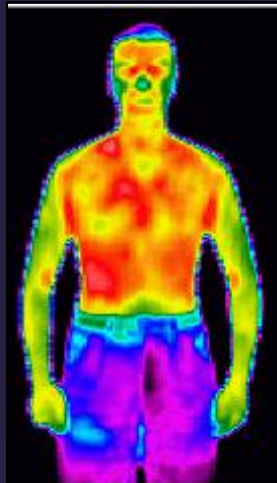
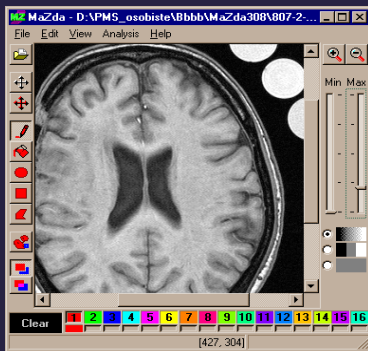
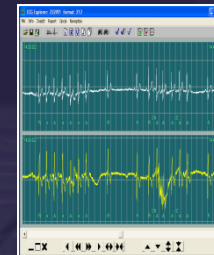
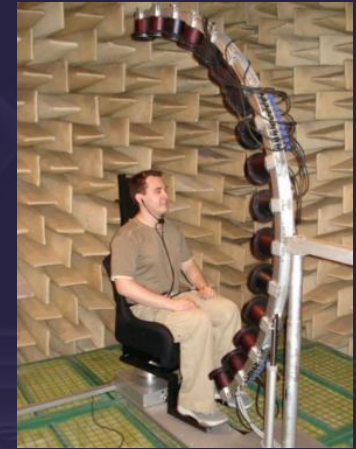




Institute of Electronics
